SENIOR CITIZEN COMPUTER SAFETY PRESENTATION

Romeo, MI. – The Macomb County Sheriff's Office, Macomb County Sheriff Anthony Wickersham along with Judge Denis LeDuc and Magistrate Jennifer Andary of the 42-1 Romeo District Court, will be hosting a computer safety presentation for senior citizens on Wednesday, 2/27/19 at the Romeo District Court.

The presentation will be given by the Macomb Area Computer Enforcement Unit (MACE) and will cover internet safety topics including identity theft, fraud, and scams targeted at senior citizens. Attendees will receive education on what these crimes entail and how to prevent themselves becoming a victim.
